### Activity ideas:

- Cut into strips, put students into teams or pairs. Apply a time limit to see how many words teams can add to the list
- Or, in a relay-game, teams have a time limit to add one word before passing the list onto the next team and receiving a different letter/list from another team. Teams will need to read the words already on the list to make sure they aren't putting down a word already there.
- Check completed lists for:
  - Good Kriol spelling
  - Good Kriol words (making sure words are used in Kriol too, not English-only)
- Completed lists can be displayed in the classroom as reference materials.
